Plan of Correction (POC)

"Plan of Correction (POC): Write a plan of correction for a CMS 2567. Include corrective action, prevention, monitoring, and responsible staff. [You can paste a single deficiency or upload the full document.]"



Policy Drafting

"Draft a nursing home policy for [topic, e.g., fall prevention or medication reconciliation]. Include purpose, scope, procedure, and staff responsibilities."



Family Communication

"Write a professional but compassionate letter/email to family members notifying them of [new policy, upcoming event, staffing change, etc]."



Staff In-Service Creation

"Write a one-page read-and-sign in-service on [topic, e.g., hand hygiene, documentation, fall prevention]. Include key points and a short 5-question quiz with an answer key."



Scenario Analysis

"A family member insists on [situation]. Write how this could be viewed from a regulatory perspective and provide options for how an administrator should respond."



Social Media

"Write 3 engaging Facebook post ideas to promote a nursing home's community events and highlight its staff and residents in a positive way."



Emergency Preparedness

"Create an tabletop emergency preparedness drill related to tornados that I can perform with my skilled nursing facility staff."



Job Descriptions

"Write a job description for an Assistant Director of Nursing in a skilled nursing facility. Include summary, key responsibilities, required qualifications, and preferred skills."



Newsletter Articles

"Write three short newsletter articles for families: (1) fall prevention tips, (2) upcoming activities, (3) resident spotlight story."



Care Plan Ideas

"We have a resident who frequently falls. The most recent fall was from bed. Current interventions are [list]. Resident is cognitively impaired and impulsive with [risk factors]. Suggest new, realistic interventions to add to their care plan."
